INTRODUCTION

Language is the most important things in communication and is used as a communication channel between nations around the world. English As an international language is really important and has many relationships with various aspects of human life. In Indonesia especially English is considered the first foreign language and is taught formally from elementary school to university level. As technology progresses, global competition is getting tougher And our generation must really be ready to face it. therefore English proficiency is very important so that our generation is able to keep up with global competition. with the country's progress. and pronounce sentences correctly through their conversation with strangers. add a sense of confidence to students to speak English, because there they will be dealing directly with people from various countries, forcing them to speak English to be able to communicate.

RESEARCH METHOD

In this reaserch used quantitative experimental reaserch method. There are several forms of pre-experimental designs, namely: One-Shot Case Study, One-Group Pretest-Posttest Design, OneGroup Pretest-Posttest Design, and Intact-Group comparison. So, the research design used in this study is the form of one-shot case study design. This research design does not have control group and not given a pretest. The treatment will be given to one group, namely some students will use the Ome Tv application to practice speaking skills following learning to speak English (X). Then the researcher will conduct interviews and test the students' English speaking skills whether they are developing or not (O).

RESULT AND DISCUSSION

This research is a pre-experimental research with a "One-Shot Case Study" design in which there is only one class that is given treatment, namely learning with recitation and demonstration methods. This research was carried out on June 9 to 15 at UNUGURI Bojonegoro. In this research, assisted by ibi Ainu Zumrudiana, M.Pd for choose 10 students from English class semester 1 to take part in this experiment.

The normality test was conducted to determine whether the data obtained were normally distributed or not. Normality test was carried out using the Liliefors method. To test the normality of the data using student test scores.The

significant level used is 0.05, After the normality test was carried out on the students' speaking test results which were declared normal, a hypothesis test was then applied to the data. Hypothesis testing is done by looking for the average and standard deviation after a new t-test is performed. the average result of the data obtained is 83.8 and the standard deviation is 13.5466 and then a one-sided test is applied, namely the right side by subtracting the average from the hypothesized value of 75 and dividing by the result of the division of the standard deviation with the existing sample and then it is found t-test result 2.054241. the results of the t-test were consulted or compared with the right-hand t-table test with $dk = 10-1 = 9$ and used a significant level of 5% which showed the t-table result of 1.8331. it is said that H_a is

accepted and H_0 is rejected if the t-test value is greater than the t-table value of the right-hand side test hypothesis. From the results of the calculation table above, it can be concluded that if H_a is accepted, H_0 is rejected. The average value of the speaking test was obtained at 83.8 which indicates the value is above the criteria. In addition, based on the results of hypothesis testing using the right-hand t-test formula, it was obtained t-count 2.054241 with $db=10-1=9$ at a significant level of 0.05, obtained t-table 1.8331 so that $t\text{-count} > t\text{-table}$, it is concluded that H_0 is rejected, H_a is accepted, which means that the use of ome tv in improving speaking skills has an effect.

CONCLUSION

The results of data analysis on student responses to the use of Ome Tv in improving English speaking skills were considered to give positive and negative responses. The results of using Ome TV in improving speaking skills show that the average score is 83.5 out of 10 students. In more detail, it is

stated that 20% of all students get a moderate score, 40% have a high score and 40% are very high. Ome tv is a social media platform that provides a worldwide network with a voice call feature, making it easier for users to practice speaking skills.

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
