ABSTRACT

The variation in communication styles used by male and female do not occur without any reason, the original characters of both genders are affected the way they communicate. It happened due to the habits that both genders carried when they communicate. Knowing the style of communication is the first step to achieve the effectiveness in communication and having a good speaking ability is the sign of effective communication

This research aimed to know the communication styles used by male and female undergraduate student and to figure out the relation of communication styles used by male and female undergraduate students in affecting their communication ability in public speaking course. Based on the aim above, the researcher identified 2 research problems: 1). How are the communication styles used by male and female undergraduate students of English education department?, 2. How are the relation between the communication styles used by male and female undergraduate students of English education department?

The researcher developed case-study research using qualitative method to get the research. Interview, questionnaire and test used to collect the data in this research. The research participants are the second years students of English Education Department of IKIP PGRI Bojonegoro years 2023/2024.

The results of questionnaire and interview shows that there are 5 students of male undergraduate students that use assertive communication style and 4 male undergraduate students use passive communication style, while only 1 male undergraduate student use aggressive communication style. On the other hand, there are 5 female undergraduate students that used passive-aggressive communication style. 3 female undergraduate students used assertive communication style and 2 students of female undergraduate students use passive communication style.

Male undergraduate students mostly used assertive communication style while female undergraduate students mostly used passive-aggressive communication style. On the other hand, the undergraduate students that used assertive communication style tend to have a good speaking ability in public speaking course rather than the undergraduate students that used passive-aggressive, passive or aggressive communication style.

Keragaman gaya berkomunikasi yang digunakan oleh laki-laki dan perempuan tidak terbentuk tanpa alasan, karakter-karakter alami dari kedua gender mempengaruhi cara mereka berkomunikasi. Hal ini terjadi karena kebiasaan yang dibawa oleh kedua gender ketika mereka berkomunikasi. Mengetahui gaya berbicara adalah Langkah pertama untuk mencapai keefektivan berkomunikasi dan memiliki kemampuan berbicara yang baik adalah salah satu tandanya.

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui gaya berkomunikasi yang digunakan oleh mahasiswa laki-laki dan perempuan dan untuk memahami pengaruh gaya berkomunikasi yang digunakan oleh mahasiswa laki-laki dan perempuan pada kemampuan berbicara mereka dalam mata kuliah public speaking. Dari tujuan tersebut, peneliti mengidentifikasi dua rumusan masalah yaitu: 1) Bagaimana gaya berkomunikasi yang digunakan oleh mahasiswa laki-laki dan perempuan?, 2. Bagaimana hubungan antara gaya berkomunikasi yang digunakan oleh mahasiswa laki-laki dan perempuan?, 2. Bagaimana hubungan antara gaya berkomunikasi yang digunakan oleh mahasiswa laki-laki dan perempuan dan kemampuan berbicara mereka dalam mata kuliah public speaking

Peneliti mengembangkan penelitian studi kasus dengan menggunakan metode penelitian qualitative untuk mendapatkan data penelitian. Wawancara, angket atau kuesioner dan tes digunakan untuk mengumpulkan data pada penelitian ini. Peserta pada penelitian ini adalah mahasiswa tahun kedua dari jurusan Pendidikan Bahasa Inggris IKIP PGRI Bojonegoro tahun 2023/2024.

Hasil dari angket dan interview menunjukkan bahwa ada 5 mahasiswa laki-laki yang menggunakan gaya berkomunikasi assertive, 4 mahasiswa laki-laki yang menggunakan gaya berkomunikasi passive dan 1 mahasiswa laki-laki yang menggunakan gaya berkomunikasi aggressive. Di sisi lain, ada 5 mahasiswa perempuan yang menggunakan gaya berkomunikasi passive-aggressive, 3 mahasiswa perempuan yang menggunakan gaya berkomunikasi assertive dan 2 mahasiswa perempuan yang menggunakan gaya berkomunikasi passive.

Mahasiswa laki-laki kebanyakan menggunakan gaya berkomunikasi assertive, sementara mahasiswa perempuan cenderung menggunakan gaya berkomunikasi passive-aggressive. Di sisi lain, mahasiswa yang menggubakan gaya berkomunikasi assertive cenderung memiliki kemampuan berbicara yang lebih baik dibandingkan dengan mahasiswa yang menggunakan gaya berbicara passive-aggressive, passive dan aggressive.

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CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

This chapter presents five topics related to the research, those topics are the research background, research question, research objective, significance of the research, definition of key terms.

A. Research Background

Communication, language and speaking have a deep relation since language is the communication tools used by every human in this world, while speaking is an integral component of language and communication, it also playing a crucial role in facilitating effective communication. Language is a media to communicate used by everyone for their daily life in order to share the information and give arguments to others (Rabiah et al., 2012). According to Brown (2001: 271), the ability to speak is inherently connected to communication. Speaking profiency can be defined as the aptitude to utilize language effectively for conveying intended meanings, facilitating the exchange of knowledge and information with others across various life situations.

All languages consist of many variation in communication. There are many factors that influence this variation including age, place, region, gender, social class and others . Social aspect like age, gender, human relationship, place, and aim can be define as social factors that influence language communication valation . Gender

can be defined as male and female, the differences between male and female not only seen from how they look, life style and fashion style but also the habits they carry when they communicate (Atmawati, 2018).

The variations in communication styles used between male and female do not occur without any reason, the original character of both genders are also affects the way they communicate, which also determines their communication styles. According to Churgai (2015) on her article said that the prevalent consensus is that female communicate more elaborately, subtly, and emotionally, which can convey the lack of confidence, authority, and hesitancy. While its generally believed that male communicate in a direct, concise, and instrumental. Society is also the main factor that causes the variation in language style between male and female. However, it may also be claimed that genderlect is a product of socialization, which differs for boys and girls as they grow older, rather than something that people select (Tench et al., 2017). Put it differently, guys and girls interact with each other differently. As a result, individuals acquire diverse communication skill. The influence of gender in communication also affects the speaking skills of both genders.

While in communication functions there are many examples of the variations of language for male and female in communication. Such as grammar form of feminine and masculine nouns that represent how gender is mentioned in language structure. Thus, it is frequently claimed that language prejudices social gender representation through its communication functions (Mondal, 2023). According to Krolokke and Sorensen on their book, said that gender and communication have undergone a significant transformation as a result of taking performance.

Communication styles and gendered communication have been mentioned several times in sociolinguistics and stylistics. According to Joose (1976 : 156) He mentioned that communication style refers to the language that use by the speaker based on the level of formality. Marcus (1987) a Romanian pshycologist classified communication styles into four styles (Passive Communication, Aggressive Communication, Passive-Aggressive Communication and Assertive Communication).

The researcher choosed to raise the topic of gender and communication, because researcher found that gender and communication is having a deep relationship that need to be explore more, communication is an important aspect that needs to be explored deeply. Communication is the most frequent activity carry out by every human. Effective communication means that what the speaker says is well received by the audience. To have an effective communication skills, individuals must know the characters and communication styles of others, so that miscommunication does not occur.

An effective communication skill is barely essential for human to enter the society. (Malik, 2018) The effective communication is crucial requirement for professional life. From the statement above we can say that effective communication is necessary in order to be able to balance the society. According to Taylor (2015) effective communication styles encompass clarity, summarization and inquiry. Knowing the style of communication is the first step to achieving the

effectiveness in communication and having a good speaking ability is the sign of effective communication.

In education, effective communication is very important in conveying educational information, so knowing the communication styles of others is very necessary so that both speakers and audiences understand easily and clearly the information conveyed. Teachers, parents, and even the kids themselves understand that the suitable style of communication improves a better comprehension as well as future professional achievement (Pânişoară et al., 2015). In todays language teaching, the discussion, introduction, and acquisition of communicative competence are highly essential for both teachers and students (Rohmah, 2020).

In this case, the variation of communication styles used by male and female are very interesting to discuss because its related to social matters which all people do every day in their dailylife.

A study on 2022 about how communication style and verbal communication of leader influence the employee performance show that lately communication is becoming a popular word and a crucial part of people life, by using LMX (leadership member exchange) theory. While in this research, the researcher used the theory of communication style by a psychologist Marcus (1987). As for the result, the tittle of this research is "An Analysis of Communication Styles Used by Male and Female Undergraduate Students".

B. Research Question

Based on the research background above, the researcher identify the research question as follows:

- 1. How are the communication styles used by male and female undergraduate students of English education department?
- 2. How are the relation between communication styles used by male and female undergraduate students of English education department and their speaking ability in public speaking course?

C. Objective of the Research

Based on the research background above, the researcher identified two aims of this research:

- To know the communication styles that used by male and female undergraduate student of English education department based on Marcus (1987) theory.
- 2. To figure out the relation of communication styles used by male and female students in and their speaking ability specifically in public speaking course.

D. Significance of the Research

There are three types of significant of this research, which are theoretically, practically, and pedagogically:

1. Theoretically

Theoretically this research is expected to be a pleasant reference for the readers who are interested in compiling research on literature, sociolinguistics, especially gender communication styles.

2. Practically

Apart from the theoretical significance, the researcher hopes that this research provides practical significance to teachers and readers.

a. Teachers

This research is supposed to help teachers in solving communication and speaking problems of their students so that it can be a reference in developing an effective-materials about communication.

b. Readers

This research is expected to be an alternative material and motivation for the readers to pay more attention on communication style so the readers able to improve their communication skill. This research may also help the readers to be more familiar with sociolinguistics.

3. Pedagogically

E. Key Term Definition

To clarify the fundamental concepts employed in this research and to avert any misapprehension of the concepts occupied in this research, the definition of communication style is put in forward:

Communication can be defined as the activity of giving and receiving information, which occurs in a variety of circumstances, such as at school, work, and leisure. A discipline of study that focuses on broadcasting and information transfer is called communication (Fatimayin, 2023).

Communication style evolves during the initial years of our lives. It is shaped by a blend of genetic and environmental influences, with individuals forming habits based on the behaviors they are exposed to as they mature. This communication habit is commonly referred to as a communication style. Our communication style comprises various elements, including vocal patterns, eye gestures, facial expressions, and body posture (Franksiska, 2006).

The communication styles in this research referred to the variety of ways of communicating. Where this variation arises because of several influencing factors. The theory of communication styles by a psychologist Marcus (1987) indicated the four distinct of communication styles: Aggressive, Passive, Assertive and Passive-Aggressive.
