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ABSTRACT

In the current era of rapid technological development, speaking ability is a crucial skill in mastering English, especially in global communication. Discord, originally designed for gamers, now functions as a flexible and free educational platform that facilitates real-time voice interaction. Using a descriptive qualitative method, the researcher conducted interviews and mock speaking tests with 15 participants who had been active members of the English server for approximately one year. The findings reveal that participants experienced increased speaking confidence, fluency, vocabulary development, and improved pronunciation. Discord's supportive, anonymous, and low-pressure environment helped reduce speaking anxiety and motivated learners to practice regularly. Compared to other platforms like Duolingo or Busuu, participants perceived Discord as more effective for improving speaking performance due to its interactive and real-time features. The study concludes that Discord can serve as a powerful tool for language learners, providing meaningful speaking practice and promoting learner autonomy outside formal classroom settings.

Discord, yang awalnya dibuat untuk para gamer, kini berkembang menjadi platform pembelajaran yang fleksibel, gratis, dan mendukung interaksi suara secara langsung. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif dengan melibatkan 15 partisipan yang telah menjadi anggota aktif server selama kurang lebih satu tahun. Data diperoleh melalui wawancara dan uji bicara tiruan. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa peserta mengalami peningkatan dalam hal kepercayaan diri, kefasihan, penguasaan kosakata, dan pelafalan. Lingkungan yang mendukung dan bebas tekanan di Discord membantu mengurangi kecemasan saat berbicara serta mendorong partisipasi aktif. Dibandingkan dengan platform lain seperti Duolingo atau Halo, Discord dianggap lebih efektif untuk meningkatkan kemampuan berbicara karena fitur interaktif dan real-time-nya. Kesimpulannya, Discord dapat menjadi sarana yang efektif untuk pembelajaran bahasa, khususnya dalam pengembangan kemampuan berbicara di luar lingkungan kelas formal.

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CHAPTER I INTRODUCTION

This chapter presents the background of the study, research questions, objective of the research, significance of the research, and definition of key terms.

A. Background of the Study

In recent years, digital communication platforms have developed rapidly and have changed the way people learn and practice languages. Among these platforms, discord has emerged as a popular communication tool, providing easyto-use, understandable and seamless features for participating in discussions or chats that allow users to easily switch between text, audio or video formats (Sufi et al., 2024). Discord currently hosts servers in various scenarios by allowing users to create profiles and join communities based on their interests (Arifianto & Izzudin, 2021). This app was originally designed for gamers to communicate easily while they play games, but has now been widely used for various purposes, including education. The emergence of language learning communities, especially discord based English learning communities, reflects the growing interest in utilizing existing technology to foster collaborative and engaging language learning environments.

One of the basic skills in language acquisition is speaking. Since the focus of using Discord is to communicate, speaking is an important skill to use Discord to its full potential. According to Rao (2019), to get the success we want to achieve in this modern world, communication skills have an important role and must be mastered to facilitate what we want to achieve. Among the four language skills, speaking is the most important language skill to communicate well in this globalized world. However, often students find this skill challenging. Due to several factors and rules in traditional schools such as time constraints, large

class sizes, speaking partners, and limited access to native speakers, a lot of students do not have enough opportunities to practice speaking. Moreover, students often experience anxiety and a lack of confidence when speaking, which further hinders their ability to express themselves fluently and effectively. A study by Rahmadani & Etfita (2022), found that foreign language speaking anxiety is prevalent among students and can significantly impede their language learning progress.

Additionally, the rigid structure of classroom activities sometimes fails to cater to individual learning needs, making it difficult for students to improve their speaking skills at their own pace. This reinforces the need to create a quality learning environment, especially one that prioritizes interactive and meaningful communication to help learners overcome these barriers and develop their speaking proficiency. In this case, discord lends itself to being the desired solution. It provides a unique solution by offering communication tools or real-time features such as being able to create servers with voice channels, chat rooms, and interactive events that allow members or users to engage in speaking practice with people or other members from various language and cultural backgrounds.

Discord is a free communication platform that allows its users to interact through text, voice and video, making it flexible for a variety of purposes. Originally, it's a proprietary application and digital distribution platform designed for video gaming communities among gamers (Fonseca,2020). Discord is now used by various communities, including in language learning. Users can create or join servers tailored to specific interests, providing a space to learn and interact. Features such as voice channels and screen sharing allow users to practice speaking and listening, follow ongoing discussions or events, and get

immediate feedback. In addition, Discord supports both direct and indirect communication, allowing learners or users to practice at any time conveniently, connecting people from different cultures, and building a supportive learning community.

It also offers additional solutions that are very useful for language learning. The platform supports various interactive activities such as group discussions, providing interesting events, or language games, which are fun and can improve language skills, especially speaking. Users can join live conversation sessions through voice channels with friends or make new acquaintances, creating real and natural conversations. With notifications and schedule settings, users or learners can set up regular speaking practice times. Discord also provides flexibility for users who are awkward or afraid of speaking in front of people, allowing them to start conversations one-on-one or in small groups, which helps build confidence. Since it is accessible on various devices, learners can practice anytime and anywhere, making Discord an effective solution to overcome obstacles in learning to speak a language.

The researcher was interested in researching Discord because the platform has had a significant impact on the development of her English language skills. Research into these online language learning platforms has highlighted to them contribute to improve skill performance and confidence in learners. However, there is limited understanding of how members experience the English server within this community and how their participation may affect their speaking skills. Given the informal and self-contained nature of this platform, it is important to explore members' perceptions, challenges and achievements in this context.

This study aims to explores the experiences of members who have been on the English server for more or less than one year and analyse the impact of participation on their speaking performance. By focusing on their perspectives and performance, this study seeks to contribute to the growing body of knowledge about free language learning platforms and provide insights into how such platforms can be optimized to hone our language skills.

This research emphasizes the role of technology in creating accessible and flexible learning environments, in line with the growing trend of digital transformation. This research shows how platforms like Discord can break down geographical and cultural barriers in learning English as a second or foreign language.

E. Definition of Key Terms

1. Speaking Performance

This is an individual ability that is essential for learning and mastering a language such as English. It includes aspects such as fluency, grammar pronunciation, vocabulary, and confidence. And if they want to master and learn a language, they must consider all the language skills, such as; writing, reading, listening, and speaking. Having a good speaking performance in learning a language is important, therefore we must at least master all skills especially in speaking skills.

2. Discord

A communication platform based on text, voice, and video, commonly used by communities for communication, discussion and collaboration between gamers. In this study, Discord serves as a medium for learning and practicing the English language.

3. English Server

A server or community on Discord that was created with a purpose focused on learning and practicing English. These servers do focus on that, but many are just free chats, which can also help practice your speaking skills. The server consists of members from different cultural and geographical backgrounds who share the same goal of improving their English. There are various events with different topics that have been differentiated in each sub voice chat that has been provided.
